

Our **Community Supported Agriculture** program provides an opportunity for community members to make a connection with local farmers and their food through a farm share. CSA helps preserve the relationship among food, families and farmers: securing the future of local agriculture and helping support the start of the farming season for small farms. The purchase of your share will include twenty consecutive weekly boxes of assorted local organic seasonal produce. Boxes also include one of our favorite cookbooks to ensure culinary success and help you utilize the delicious produce in your CSA. A newsletter is distributed periodically updating you about what is happening in the fields and the farming community. You will get to know your farmer, understand what seasonal means and know where your food is coming from.

Our Farm Account Program, **Bunny Bucks**, is a pre-paid account system that supports the farmer as the season is starting, gives customers 10% more purchase power, and allows you the flexibility to shop throughout the season at the Farmers Market from April through December 2017.

EARLY SEASON:

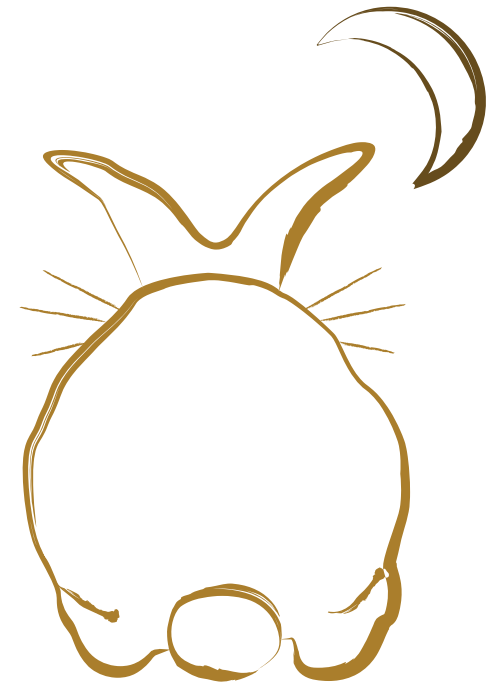
strawberries, sugar snap peas, snow peas, green onions, Lettuce, Kale, Swiss chard, Cabbage, Spinach, Fresh herbs, Arugula, Mustard greens, Bok choy, salad mix, Beets, Carrots, Radishes, Turnips, Garlic greens, Beans, Cilantro, sprouts.

PEAK SEASON:

Raspberries, Broccoli, Cauliflower, Tomatoes, green onions, Lettuce, Kale, Swiss chard, Cabbage, Basil, Kohlrabi, spinach, Fresh herbs, Arugula, salad mix, Beets, Carrots, Zucchini, Onions, Radishes, Artichokes, Mustard greens, Bok choy, Tomatillos, Fennel, Potatoes.

LATE SEASON:

Broccoli, Cauliflower, Braising mix, green onions, Lettuce, Kale, Eggplant, Swiss chard, Peppers, Cabbage, Kohlrabi, Spinach, Pie pumpkins, Fresh herbs, Arugula, salad mix, winter squash, Beets, Carrots, Onions, Radishes, Potatoes, Turnips, Artichokes, Mustard greens, Bok choy, Tomatillos, Fennel, sun chokes, Leeks, Garlic, Beans, Brussel sprouts, Cilantro, sprouts.

 Similarly, with one week advanced notice of your absence we will give credit for the value of that week's box to be used at the market at a later date.
(only one week's worth of credit will be issued per box each season)
